



#### **Treasurer's report**

### **TBPA Annual Conference 2010**

Everyone is encouraged to book rooms now. Deadline is September 13th for discount. Kitty will put this on the web site. Kitty will mail the registration forms ASAP. Speakers were discussed and finalized.

Board voted to buy long sleeve T-shirts with a pocket in heather gray with dark blue writing.

Board voted to pay \$300 travel for a National representative to attend the Conference only after they attend. Money was sent for Curtiss to travel last year and she did not attend.

### **Annual Awards**

Kent needs nominations for the Annual Awards and Angel needs the winner's names by October 4th to get the plaques made.

### **Residential Inspections**

This issue was discussed at the last Board Meeting. Robert Foster wrote a letter saying 5% of residential homes have to be "physically" surveyed - thus making this a mandate because it was written by a director.

TAUD was informed that the State is looking for the following on a Sanitary Survey: 5% residential surveys, enforcement of testing and repair, pubic education, and annual testing of devices.

This was discussed at length. The Board wants a speaker at the Conference to address the issue.

Kent reported on the Expo. TBPA furnished a fishing reel for the silent auction and a Leatherman

#### **ABPA National Conference**

Angel updated the Board on the conference activities. Total ABPA Membership 3,826. 150 members attended the Conference.

The ABPA Board voted to remove two director at large positions form the Board. Other conference issues were discussed at length; including: Discovery Channel Backflow Video, Grants to off-set Education Materials, Removal of tester's certificate if abused, Resource Manual, and Communication. 190 Scholarship applications were received.

TBPA won the PACE Award and Larry Stinnett won the Golden Eagle Award. The presentation TBPA made to Mr. Lashlee is supposed to be in an upcoming issue of the ABPA Magazine.

Deadline for Awards for National is March 1st. Curtiss is supposed to send Angel an Awards Manual.

2011 Conference will be held in San Antonio, Texas.
