The High Cost of Untrained
Backflow Installers
By Kris Munson, Watts Water Technologies

We continue to look at the high cost of using untrained labor to install a backflow device. The factor we will discuss in this newsletter that may add to this hidden cost is: The wrong size of device was installed.

Wrong Size

Another concern that could be raised is when a different size backflow preventer is installed versus what was specified or what was needed. Most people believe bigger is better, that rarely applies in backflow prevention, and similarly, under sizing a backflow preventer can also cause a host of problems.

When a larger than needed unit is installed, it not only increases the cost of the initial installation, but will also increase the costs in the future with potentially more expensive tests, repair parts, and service calls to the unit. These issues may come up from the very beginning and cause problems for the building occupant resulting in callbacks of the installing contractor or the backflow tester. The net result is an unhappy occupant, unhappy contractor and an unhappy backflow installer.

Similar to upsizing the backflow, downsizing the backflow to a size smaller than what is required may save money in the short term with a lower installed cost, but in the future there may be increased service calls due to improper or high flow through the unit, warranty issues if it is verified by the manufacturer that the unit is operating outside of the designed parameters and at high flow there may be noise issues and increased wear on the internal components. Another issue that my be experienced due to extreme high flow is damage to the checks that will prevent them from operating correctly, thereby reducing or eliminating the level of backflow prevention depending on the severity of the failure.

Extensive rework of the incoming water supply may be necessary to correct this problem, from setter and backflow change out, to complete replacement of the incoming water supply and related piping, both of which are expensive options to all parties involved with the backflow preventer.


