


## **TAUD Expo**

Testing Outside Devices in the Summer

During the Summer months, it's important to stay safe. So, for those of you who test devices during these hot summer days, please remember to be careful in the heat, stay hydrated and be familiar with the warning signs of heat exhaustion and heat stroke.

Symptoms of heat exhaustion can include: fever higher than 104 degrees, excessive thirst, nausea, fainting, cool and clammy skin, weakness, muscle aches, heavy sweating and dizziness.

Heat stroke may develop following heat exhaustion if the condition is not treated. It occurs when the body's temperature rises and the cooling system stops working.



This potentially life threatening condition symptoms are: nausea, vomiting, headache, dizziness, fatigue, hot and dry skin, shortness of breath and decreased urination.

If you or someone you are working with shows signs of either of these conditions, immediately seek medical attention.
