East Tennessee News

Hi Everyone,

I hope everyone is having a great summer so far. We all know it has been a hot dry summer so far with very little rain here in East Tn.

For me testing the irrigation backflows this year our spring was so wet that 50% of what I test in May and part of June was not on due to how wet the spring was and then starting the first of June no rain and then the high heat temperatures the customers were wanting them turned on and what I have heard from some irrigation companies they could not turn them on fast enough that they were weeks behind and in return now I and really behind now to go back to all that was off on my first trip. I have noticed over the 23 years I have tested

backflows that when I go in June and then I go back to the ones that was not on in September many that was not on in June are on in September. (I am guessing 30% not on by the end of June are on in September) and for me if it is not on, I do not get paid so on some I will make 3 trips to see if it had been turned on in September. I have had some say if it is not on, I wouldn't go back especially if I didn't get paid anything if it wasn't on the first trip, but my job is to protect the water supply and I know how some people are, they

see you in the area they will go turn it off in the ground or the #1 shutoff valve. It sometimes turns into a game of cat and mouse and over the years with the people who cut them off when they see me, I usually catch them on later. Years ago, I would start in the back of the subdivisions and work my way to the entrance because they never knew I was in there verses if started at the entrance, they would see me and go cut them off until I left that subdivision.

Also, I would like to say congratulations to Kathy Riley for being the new ABPA VP and Josh Legg for being the new Region 3 Director and I am sure both will do a great job in the new positions they now have. If anyone wants to run for the East Tn. director starting in January, you can reach out to me or anyone on the board.
